The MN SNAP mobile unit delivers high-quality spay and neuter services for animals belonging to shelters, rescues and low-income pet owners in Minnesota.

MN SNAP can reach neighborhoods where cost, transportation, or the absence of veterinary services is an obstacle to obtaining animal health care and spay-neuter services.



MN SNAP was created by a licensed veterinarian and a group of animal advocates with a goal of reducing the death and suffering of homeless animals all across Minnesota.

Why You Should Participate in Pins For Pets

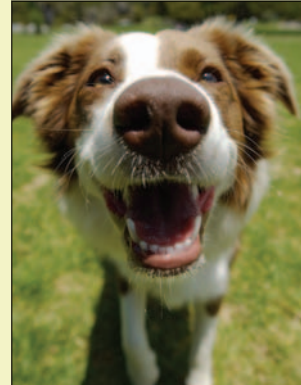
Bowling is a sport that anyone can take part in because you don't have to be good at it to have a lot of fun.

STEP 1: TO REGISTER: Just go to www.PinsForPets.org and click on the 'Register Now' link which will take you to the First Giving web site, then click on 'Get Started'.

STEP 2: Confirms you want to register for Pins For Pets, select 'Yes' and continue.

STEP 3: Fill in how many bowlers you wish to register. Read the waiver, click if you agree, and continue.

STEP 4: Log in or create an account with the appropriate information.

STEP 5: Identify whether you're registering yourself or someone else.

STEP 6: Enter all information for each person you are registering.

STEP 7: Select an existing team or create a new team. This information is important because it determines lane assignments.

STEP 8: Confirm the information is correct and complete payment details. You can create a fundraising page now or later by clicking on the link.

FUNDRAISING MADE EASY!

Set up your own personal Pins For Pets fundraising web page by clicking the link when you complete the registration process.

Even if you're not going to bowl, you can have a fundraising page. Simply go to: www.FirstGiving.com/PinsForPets and click on the 'Get Started' button, then follow the instructions. It's super easy! Create your 'homepage' with your personal story and photos. Then you can email your fundraising page to all your friends.

They can make a donation to your fundraising page right online, and it's very easy to manage your account. It's a wonderful tool to keep track of all your donations, and a way for your family and friends to watch your donations grow, knowing they're going directly to the Minnesota Spay Neuter Assistance Program (MN SNAP).
